Ask your students about these fun activities that we did in November:

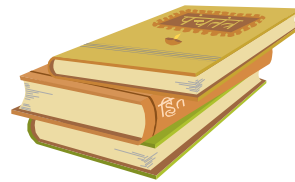
- ~Creating “animal skins” with Native American symbolic writing on them
