READING & LANGUAGE ARTS



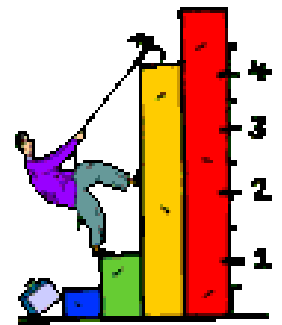
~We will be reading Theme 3 which takes a close look at the revolutionary period in the U.S.
