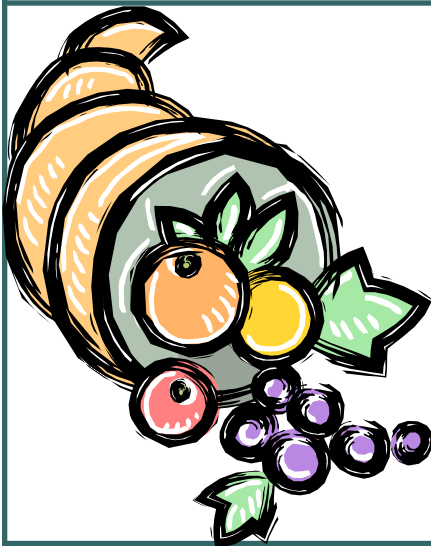


Outdoor School was a

The following list was created by the students in class:

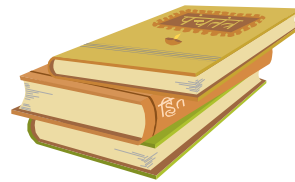

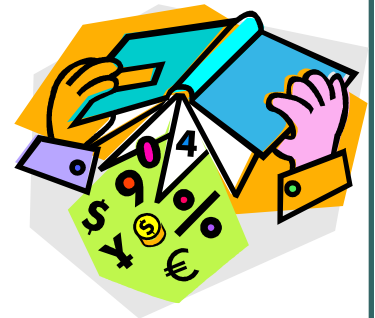
